REMAND HEARING
EIGHTH PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On September 30, 2005, the Commission issued Decision No. 68176, granting a rate increase to Chaparral City Water Company ("Chaparral City"). The parties to Decision No. 68176 include Chaparral City, the Residential Utility Consumer Office ("RUCO"), and the Commission's Utilities Division Staff ("Staff"). Chaparral City appealed Decision No. 68176 to the Arizona Court of Appeals.

The Arizona Court of Appeals, Division One, considered Chaparral City's appeal, and on February 13, 2007, issued its Memorandum Decision which Affirmed in Part, Vacated, and Remanded Decision No. 68176 to the Commission for further determination.

On June 7, 2007, the Commission issued a Remand Hearing Procedural Order in this docket establishing a schedule for a remand proceeding in accordance with the Memorandum Decision.

The hearing was held on January 28 and 29, 2008, and at the conclusion of the hearing, a briefing schedule was set.

On February 14, 2008, Chaparral City filed a Motion to Modify Briefing Schedule ("Motion"). In its Motion, Chaparral City requested that the deadline for closing briefs be extended from February 20, 2008 to February 27, 2008, and that the deadline for reply briefs be extended from March 7, 2008 to March 14, 2008. All parties of record had no objection to the extension.

1 On February 15, 2008, by Procedural Order, Chaparral City's Motion was granted and the
2 deadlines for closing briefs and reply briefs were extended to February 27, 2008, and March 14,
3 2008, respectively.

4 On February 20, 2008, Staff filed a Request for an Extension of Time for Filing of Briefs
5 requesting that the date for filing the parties' closing briefs be extended to March 5, 2008, and that
6 the date for filing the parties' reply briefs be extended to March 21, 2008. Staff indicated that the
7 Company and the Residential Utility Consumer Office do not oppose Staff's request for the
8 extension. Accordingly, Staff's request is reasonable and should be granted.

9 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that **closing briefs shall be filed on or before March 5,**
10 **2008.**

11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **reply briefs shall be filed on or before March 21, 2008.**

12 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all other requirements of prior remand proceeding
13 procedural orders remain in effect.

14 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized
15 Communications) continues to apply to this proceeding.

16 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend, or waive
17 any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.
