15 **SURREBUTTAL AND REJOINDER TESTIMONY**


16 The Residential Utility Consumer Office ("RUCO") hereby requests to continue
17 Surrebuttal and Rejoinder Testimony filing deadlines. The parties are attempting to resolve the
18 major issues in this matter and need additional time to file testimony in order to pursue that
19 goal. Due to resource issues and conflicting time commitments associated with the Open
20 Meeting and resolution of the APS proceeding, neither RUCO nor Staff is able to submit
21 surrebuttal testimony on January 18, 2012. Instead, the Parties have agreed that the filing
22 deadlines for Staff, RUCO and other Intervenors will be separated and continued so that
23 RUCO and other Intervenors will have the benefit of reviewing Staff's rebuttal testimony prior
24 to filing their testimony. The Parties have also agreed that the Company's rejoinder should be

1 continued. Consistent with that agreement, RUCO requests the extension of the pre-filed
2 testimony deadlines as follows:

- 3 Staff's Surrebuttal Testimony January 27, 2012
- 4 RUCO's/IBEW's/Intervernors Surrebuttal Testimony February 1, 2012
- 5 Company's Rejoinder February 3, 2012

6 The Company, Staff and IBEW all concur in this request, but due to time limitations, the
7 Parties have not been able to circulate a stipulated motion for signature. In lieu of a signed
8 stipulation, all of the Parties have agreed that RUCO may file this motion and represent their
9 verbal concurrence.


